GMRC is looking for an enthusiastic project manager to plan and manage a habitat restoration project on three species of concern (ie. Atlantic salmon, Atlantic sturgeon and American eel) in the Restigouche watershed and its estuary. The successful candidate will oversee the contribution agreement, run GIS-based models, plan and carry out restoration activities, complete reports, and lead team meetings.

Qualifications

A Bachelor's degree in Science (Biology, Geography, etc.) and project management experience are required. Experience working with First Nations is an asset; Multilingual (Mi'gmaq/English/French) desired; experience with habitat restoration efforts, species knowledge, GIS and LiDAR experience are considered to be assets. Driver's license is required.
